

AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CAIRO REGIONAL CENTRE FOR INTERNATIONAL
COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION
AND
THE JAPAN COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION

APRIL 19th, 1990

The Cairo Regional Centre for International Commercial Arbitration (Centre) and The Japan Commercial Arbitration Association (Association);

Being convinced that wider use of commercial arbitration for settlement of disputes would lend confidence and stability to trade and economic transactions, in the Asian and African region, have agreed as follows:

1. The Centre and the Association shall cooperate in popularizing arbitration as a means of settling disputes arising from international economic and commercial transactions and, for that purpose, shall undertake, in particular, organisation of seminars, conferences and educational programmes whenever appropriate.
2. The Centre and the Association shall endeavor to promote wider use of arbitration under the rules of arbitration of or to be administered by, the respective organisations.
3. The Centre and the Association shall provide to each other, upon request, facilities of administrative services for arbitration under the rules of arbitration of, or to be administered by, the other organisation. Such expenses as are incurred by the requested organisation, if any, shall be borne by the requesting organisation.
4. The Centre and the Association shall exchange information, publications, materials or data of mutual interest as may be at their disposal in the field of international commercial arbitration.
5. (a) The term of this Agreement shall be an indefinite period. Either organisation may, however, terminate this Agreement by giving six months' prior written notice to the other.
(b) In the event of termination of this Agreement as provided in paragraph (a) above, the organisation giving the notice shall take necessary steps to ensure that such termination is not prejudicial to any activities then in progress.
6. The Centre and the Association shall, at the request of either organisation, consult on any question concerning the interpretation or operation of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties to this Agreement, each acting through its authorized representative, have signed this Agreement on the date first above written in two originals, in the English language both being equally authentic.
