

**AGREEMENT
AMONG
THE ASIAN-AFRICAN LEGAL CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE,
THE REGIONAL CENTRE FOR ARBITRATION AT KUALA LUMPUR
(ACTING THROUGH THE ASIAN-AFRICAN LEGAL
CONSULTATIVE COMMITTEE)
AND
THE JAPAN COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION**

Being convinced that a wider use of commercial arbitration would lend confidence and stability to commercial and economic transactions in the Asian and African region, the Asian-African Legal Consultative Committee (referred to as the "Committee"), the Regional Centre for Arbitration at Kuala Lumpur (referred to as the "Regional Centre") and the Japan Commercial Arbitration Association (referred to as the "JCAA") have agreed as follows:

1. The Committee, the Regional Centre and the JCAA will cooperate in promoting international commercial arbitration and in particular by jointly or separately organizing seminars, conferences and educational programmes whenever appropriate.
2. The Regional Centre and the JCAA shall provide to each other, upon request, facilities for the holding of arbitration proceedings under their auspices or their respective Rules. Such expenses as are incurred by the concerned party, if any, shall be, upon request, reimbursed by the party requesting for the above facilities.
3. The Regional Centre and the JCAA will cooperate, within the limit of their respective function, in providing assistance in the enforcement of arbitral awards particularly where the enforcement is sought of awards rendered in arbitration proceedings under their auspices or their respective Rules.
4. The Regional Centre and the JCAA will exchange from time to time all available information, publications and statistics of mutual interest on international commercial arbitration.
5. The Committee, the Regional Centre and the JCAA will consult at the request of either party and discuss any question concerning the operation of this Agreement.
